Fatima: Part 2, The Apparitions

There were six Marian apparitions to the shepherd children from May 13 to October 13, 1917. All but one took place on the 13th of the month. They were preceded by three apparitions of the Angel of Peace in 1916 who prepared the children for the Marian apparitions by teaching them prayers and in the angel's final apparition, autumn 1916, giving them Holy Communion.

May 13, 1917. Blessed Mary appears for the first time. Blessed Mary urged the children to "Pray the Rosary every day, to obtain peace for the world, and the end of the war (World War I)." She instructed the children to come to the same place at the same time every 13th day of the month for the next five months.

June 13. Our Lady appeared and instructed the children to continue to say the Rosary every day and for Lucia to learn to read and write. Lucia was told she would live longer than the other two children and that she should spread the message of Mary throughout mankind. She told Lucia that God wants to "establish devotion to my Immaculate Heart in the world." Whoever embraces it is promised salvation.

July 13. In addition to urging the children to continue to say the Rosary for peace in the world, Blessed Mary told the children to pray for the conversion of sinners and all the sins committed against her Immaculate Heart. Our Lady disclosed a 3-part secret to the children [Secrets next week].

August 19. The children missed the 13th as they were detained by anti-clerical authorities, imprisoned and released on August 15. The Lady appeared near their home, asked them to pray the Rosary daily and told them she would perform a miracle in October.

Sept. 13. She asked them to continue the Rosary daily for the end of the war and that Jesus and St. Joseph would appear in October.

Oct. 13. This was the most dramatic apparition. Over 70,000 people stood under a torrential rain. Blessed Mary appeared and revealed her identity: "I am the Lady of the Rosary." She said she desired a chapel to be built in her honor and that the war was going to end and not to offend the Lord our God anymore. Then the miracle she promised happened: the Miracle of the Sun. The sun started spinning, grew larger and appeared it was going to fall. Although it was raining, everyone's clothes were dry. The 3 children saw St. Joseph with the Christ Child.

Protecting our Children and Young People

Did you know? The Charter for the Protection of Children and Young People was established by the USCCB in June 2002. It is a comprehensive set of procedures for addressing allegations of abuse of minors. The Charter for the Protection of Children and Young People includes guidelines for reconciliation, healing, accountability, and prevention of future acts of abuse. There is no statute of limitations for removing a cleric who has sexually abused a minor from public ministry in the Catholic Church. A cleric against whom there is an established or admitted act of child sexual abuse is permanently removed from the priesthood, regardless of when the abuse occurred.
