MEMORIAL DAY

Monday is Memorial Day, the day we honor the memories of the armed forces members who never made it to veteran status because they were killed fighting for our country in wars, police actions, peace-keeping missions or terrorist attacks.

Memorial Day started as an event to honor Union soldiers who had died during the American Civil War. After WWI, it was extended to include all men and women who died in any war or military action. Memorial Day was originally known as Decoration Day until 1868, when it was officially proclaimed a holiday by Gen. John Logan, National Commander of the Grand Army of the Republic. It was held on May 30 until 1971 when, because of the Uniform Holidays Bill, it was moved to the last Monday in May.

Memorial Day can certainly be considered a Catholic American holiday for the respect and honor for the dead, and the connection between the buried body that awaits resurrection and the soul that has gone before it, are definitely Catholic themes.

Memorial Day is a special time to pray for the souls in Purgatory, especially those who died in the service of our country.
