Vessels line up by Bonnie Castel and proceed upriver to Casino Island at 2:15 p.m. where clergy will be waiting on the Uncle Sam Boat Line's *Liberty*. Fatima: Part 3, Secrets and Conclusion

During the 3rd apparition of Fatima, July 13, 1917, Our Lady revealed three secrets to the children.

The first secret was a vision of hell, after which she taught the children a prayer to be recited after each decade of the Rosary (O My Jesus).

The second secret concerned the end of WWI, and the warning of a worse war during the time of Pope Pius XI if people did not cease offending God.

As for the third secret, according to Lucia, the Virgin asked her to put it in writing, and to have her bishop deliver it to Pope Pius XII. In the sealed envelope containing the message, Lucia also indicated that it was to be revealed after 1960. The Vatican released it only in 2000.

[The third secret](#) describes an angel with a flaming sword in his left hand crying out: Penance, penance, penance." Then, a "bishop dressed in White," which Lucia and the two others believed was the pope, "killed by a group of soldiers who fired bullets and arrows at him," killing also bishops, priests, men and women religious and lay people.

According to the interpretation offered by the doctrinal congregation, the three secrets involve Hell, World War I and World War II, and the 1981 Pope John Paul II assassination attempt.

Bringing this Third Secret to our present time, Pope Francis referred to the Nov. 13, 2015 Paris attacks as a "piecemeal World War III," Catholic Online reported.

Catholic Online continued, "In essence, the Holy Father is explaining that World War III has begun, at least in a piecemeal fashion. The level of violence around the world is rising rapidly, fueled chiefly by militant Islamists.

Penance, Penance, Penance! Our Lady has always had one message for the world, and that is the conversion of hearts. Only through the conversion of hearts can the world be saved. Our best action is to ensure that our own hearts are converted, and trusting in the Third Secret, it begins with penance." [Catholic Online]
