Missionary zeal has always been a telling sign of the vitality of the Catholic Church. Located on the shores of the Mediterranean Sea, Lattakia is home to the oldest Christian settlements on earth. They are experiencing a large influx of refugees which has doubled their relief efforts but depleted their resources to do so effectively. Our "*Solidarity in Faith*" endeavor will provide concrete ways for the faithful of our Diocese to learn about Lattakia while supporting their relief programs and furthering pastoral goals like catechism for children and adults, formation programs, and marriage preparation. Our parishes will offer prayers and sacrifices for the Diocese of Lattakia as we emphasize relationships over resources, practice mutuality and equality, seek to give and receive, while we learn about the strong faith of the Church in the Middle East.

The **Missionary Projects of the Diocese of Ogdensburg** Appeal will also continue to be used to provide financial support of our former mission in Mollendo, Peru, support the United States Bishops' annual Appeal for Latin America, and assist other missionary projects throughout the world as part of our evangelization efforts.
